No. 2019AP1389-OA <u>Vos v. Kaul</u>

On August 1, 2019, a petition for leave to commence an original action under Wis. Stat. § 809.70 and a supporting legal memorandum were filed on behalf of petitioners, Robin Vos, in his official capacity as the Wisconsin Assembly Speaker; Roger Roth, in his official capacity as the Wisconsin Senate President; Jim Steineke, in his official capacity as the Wisconsin Assembly Majority Leader; and Scott Fitzgerald in his official capacity as the Wisconsin Senate Majority Leader. Pursuant to this court's orders, a response to the petition was filed on behalf of the respondent, Josh Kaul, in his official capacity as the Wisconsin Attorney General, and a reply in support of the petition was filed by the petitioners. By order dated September 12, 2019, this court held the petition in abeyance pending oral argument in Service Employees International Union, Local 1 v. Vos (SEIU v. Vos), Nos. 2019AP614-LV and 2019AP622, and pending further order of the court.

On November 12, 2019, the petitioners filed a motion for temporary injunctive relief and for merits briefing and oral argument on all issues during the 2019-2020 court term, with a supporting affidavit by Attorney Misha Tseytlin. On November 19, 2019, Attorney General Kaul filed a motion requesting a deadline of December 20, 2019, for him to file a response to the petitioners' motion. On November 20, 2019, the petitioners filed a response to Attorney General Kaul's motion.

Vos v. Kaul

On July 9, 2020, the court issued its decision in <u>SEIU v. Vos</u>, 2020 WI 67, 393 Wis. 2d 38, 946 N.W.2d 45 (Nos. 2019AP614-LV and 2019AP622).

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for leave to commence an original action is denied; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all pending motions in this matter are denied as moot.
